Get On the Bus (GOTB) is an exciting, FREE after school program open to 4th and 5th grade students at elementary schools in the Miami Community Charter Schools district. Get On the Bus means:

- Once a week, students will receive an afterschool snack, complete his/her homework, and participate in a short, fun
 healthy play activity to promote a healthy and active lifestyle (for example, the importance of drinking water or playing
 outside every day).
- After snack and homework, the student will have soccer practice at the school field with school staff members or coaches who are trained in teaching and mentoring young student athletes.
- The student must be picked up by a parent or guardian or transportation will be arranged.
- The student will be playing in a local Recreational League. Games will be played at local fields on Saturdays. There will be bus transportation to/from the fields for GOTB players only (family and friends are encouraged to come to games but must provide their own transportation).






